

HAPPY LITIZENS @LITWIT CLUB

LitWit Club is one among 20 associations in RG CET, which aims to build love in all forms of literary work with fair amount of wits within. The active members of this association activity are called as Litizens (i.e., Literary Club Citizens) The club is swarmed with fun-filled activities such as Proverbial Dumb-Charade, SpellBee, Word Game, Story Telling etc., On top of all these, there is a feature movie show every afternoon session that precedes student's perception on the movie.

The Club started number of initiatives which include a course in Japanese and German. Students enrolled in Japanese and the course started in 20th July by Shri. Adikessavane from Pondicherry University. The course consists of 2 hour sessions for a period of 8 months on every Fridays and Saturdays. Technical students with a skill set of Japanese and German is a one-way ticket to higher studies or career choice in these European countries.

The other initiative is **STEP (Standardised Test of English Proficiency)**, which is an **adaptive training program** for English language proficiency from THE HINDU GROUP. STEP is a 40 hour online course that starts with a **diagnostic test** to access the current level of proficiency of a student and continues with video lectures on appropriate themes. Finally there is a certification test that is benchmarked to global standards (CEFR Scale) which renders the knowledge requisite for IELTS and TOEFL examinations. Students under LITWIT club are encouraged to participate in Tamil language activities also. There is a state level debate competition in Tamil on 22nd July with cash prizes ranging from Rs 2000 to Rs 1,00,000 for college students. Two of our students Suprabha M and Kanimozhi .B from 4th year CSE Department had participated in this competition.
